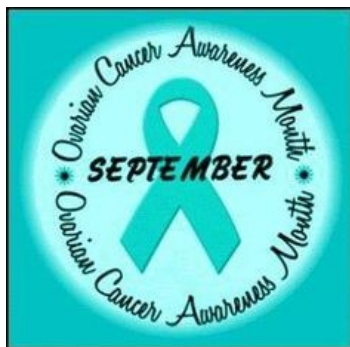

## FEATURED BOARD MEMBER: ANDREW GODWIN, PHD

Andrew "Andy" Godwin, obtained his PhD in Molecular Biology from the University of Pennsylvania. He is a professor of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine and director of Molecular Oncology at the University of Kansas Medical Center (KUMC).

He was named a Kansas Bioscience Authority Eminent Scholar in 2010, the KUMC Chancellor's Distinguished Chair in Biomedical Sciences Endowed Professor in 2012, and the Deputy Director of the KU Cancer Center (KUCC) in 2013. Dr. Godwin

co-leads the ovarian cancer program at KUCC. He states, "I have dedicated most of my scientific career to better understanding the causes and potential cures for ovarian cancer." Serving on the Vicki Welsh Board, allows him to help educate the public and serve as a voice for courageous women.

### The Four Primary Symptoms of Ovarian Cancer are:

- Bloating
  - Pelvic or abdominal pain
  - Urinary Frequency
  - Difficulty eating or feeling full too quickly
- Other symptoms may include:

- Indigestion, gas, nausea
- Constipation, diarrhea
- Abnormal bleeding, painful intercourse
- Shortness of breath
- Unusual fatigue
- Unexpected weight gain/loss

Symptoms can be vague, but 95% of women report these symptoms. If you experience these symptoms from time to time, do not be alarmed. If symptoms persist for two or more weeks, please consult your physician.
